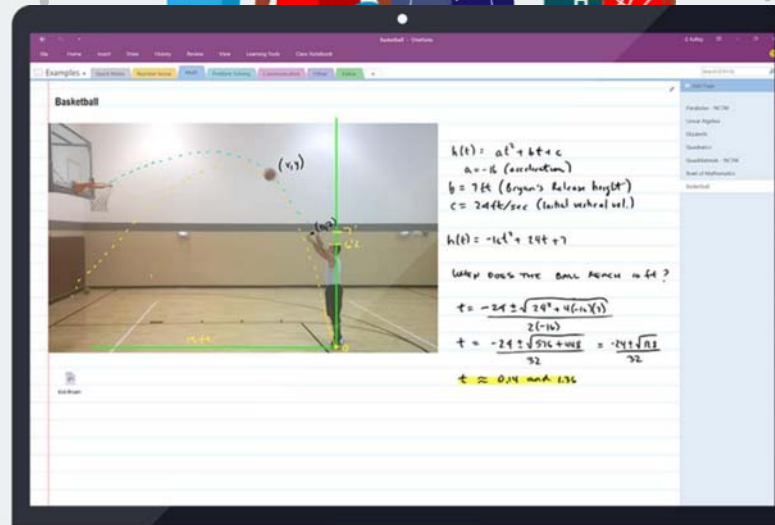
A BLENDED APPROACH TO LEARNING.



Teachers will create their courses in OneNote for students to access. Content will be drawn from Claned.



Students will access courses in Teams and use it to communicate with peers and teachers.



Teachers will use Claned to curate their course content and to access analytics. Students use it to rate content and to create portfolios of evidence.



Teachers will use the suite of O365 productivity tools as part of their lessons to help students engage, collaborative and communicate.

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
